Water Hardship Policy

M/2/C (B. Leader, B. Kurtz) to adopt and authorize the LCWSA to apply the Customer Water Leak Hardship Policy when a case comes up. If a water customer has a substantial leak they will incur a large spike in their quarterly bill. This policy helps provide some relief to those customers who experience excessive leaks that would create a financial hardship.
