Richard C Palermo High Impact Award

The Richard C Palermo High Impact Award was created and presented to Dick on September 21, 2006. It is in his memory that a resident is honored for their significant contributions to one or more community organizations. Dick was a member of the Livonia community for about 12 years. In that brief time, he helped several organizations accomplish great things. Dick played a key role in helping Freedom Park to be developed as it is today. He also was pivotal in getting St Matthew Church built. Later, he worked with leaders and students at Livonia School District to help create opportunities for young people to experience authentic problem solving and life changing educational experiences.

A recipient of the Richard C Palermo High Impact Award will have had a profound impact on the organization(s) he or she serves and, as a result, the entire Livonia Community.
