

# **SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING, TOWN OF LIVONIA**

February 6, 2025

A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Livonia, County of Livingston and the State of New York was held at Livonia Town Hall, 35 Commercial St Livonia NY 14487

The Town Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gott at 7:00 PM.  
Supervisor Gott led the pledge.

## **DISCUSSION**

Attorney Campbell introduced Attorney Brad Pinsky. Mr. Campbell stated there are two things to do tonight. The first being addressing technical things that we learned, and changes needed to be in full compliance of the law. Thus far, everyone involved has done a great job, but there are some organizational rules and regulations that perhaps need some changes. The most challenging topic will be what the future of the ambulance service looks like in the Town of Livonia.

The Goal needs to be set by the Town and the Ambulance Service. What does the best affordable service look like and what amount of money will provide for proper staffing.

Attorney Campbell asked the Town Board to start with a range of money the board thinks they can reasonably commit to ambulance services and then what can be done with that. Supervisor Gott wants to be able to afford EMS for the town. Councilmember Breu stated that minimum staffing must be looked at. The Town board has previously allocated \$60,000 of town money. Third party billing brings in about 600,000.

The Town of Conesus allocated \$18,000 for EMS services. The Town Board would like for the ambulance district to review how many calls were serviced in Conesus over the last five years.

The Town Board discussed that \$200,000 is the highest amount the board would be willing to consider. At this point the Board believes that it is best to refine the necessary model in which the EMS would run, and then consider funds to be allocated.
